REF: IMPACT LETTER ON THE FEEDING PROGRAM.

Receive greeting from Holy family Rehabilitation center.

Before we used to receive support from Health Help Zambia, we had a number of challenges at school in relation to feeding our learners especially those with disabilities. Some days would pass without food, this increased the number of absenteeism. That time we had 122, children of which 39 were living with varying disabilities. Food to take care of these children was not assured. We depended on well wishers who would contribute on certain days but when they didn't contribute meaning no food for the children.

With Health Help Zambia coming on board things have changed. When we receive the K5000.00 monthly, we immediately deposit it in the account that it reflects as money coming in then after a day, we withdrawal and buy food staffs for the children. We have a committee at school that buys the food staffs and accounts for how each ngwee was spent with receipts.

The number of learners has increased from 122 children before we started getting the support from HHZ, now we have 169 learners. Some days would pass without food when we depended on well wishers to come on board, and even when they used to come on board, we would cook porridge or magwaza (boiled maize Grains) for the learners, but since HHZ came on board our learners are

eating rice, sappo and nshima twice a week with different types of relish kapenta, chicken, beans, eggs, soya chalks among others. Most children especially those with disabilities keep asking their parents on Saturdays and Sundays why they are not going to school, as they are assured to having a meal, thanks to HHZ and its donors for coming on board to helping children who most of them couldn't afford three meals a day. So, when at school they eat well and it becomes the main meal of the day.
